6. Concern

A good number of students are coming late to our school. Inorder to eradicate this bad practice, we need the serious involvement of the parents and students. Dear parents, as a school it has the responsibility to maintain discipline of students. Inspite of warning many times some of the students are coming late everyday to the school and this challenges the morale of the disciplined students who are punctual. We have to be disciplined and so I wish to take the following measures. Now onwards, we will keep a record at the reception counter. All class teachers will keep the same record of their classes. In the event of late coming for the first time, the student should give the reason for their late coming in writing and get it signed by their class teacher and then get the permission and a white warning card from the Vice principal/Headmistress, before they enter the class.

If the same student repeats the second time, the same procedure will be repeated and they will get a yellow warning card from the Principal. If they are late for the third time, after the procedures, they will get the last red warning card from Manager and if they commit the same mistake, the late coming child will not be allowed to enter the class that day. We are going to implement this system from December 1st onwards.



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I need the full support of the parents, students and teachers to teach our students about the value of punctuality.

7. <u>Fees</u>

I am thankful to 90% of parents who were punctual in depositing the school fee at the appropriate time. Still a good number of parents have to clear the second term fees. I request all the parents to **deposit the school fee by December 7**th and collect the hall ticket to appear for the examination. Hope all of you will take it seriously and deposit the fees on time. I request all parents to deposit the last instalment by January 20th, 2023 to appear for the final exam.
